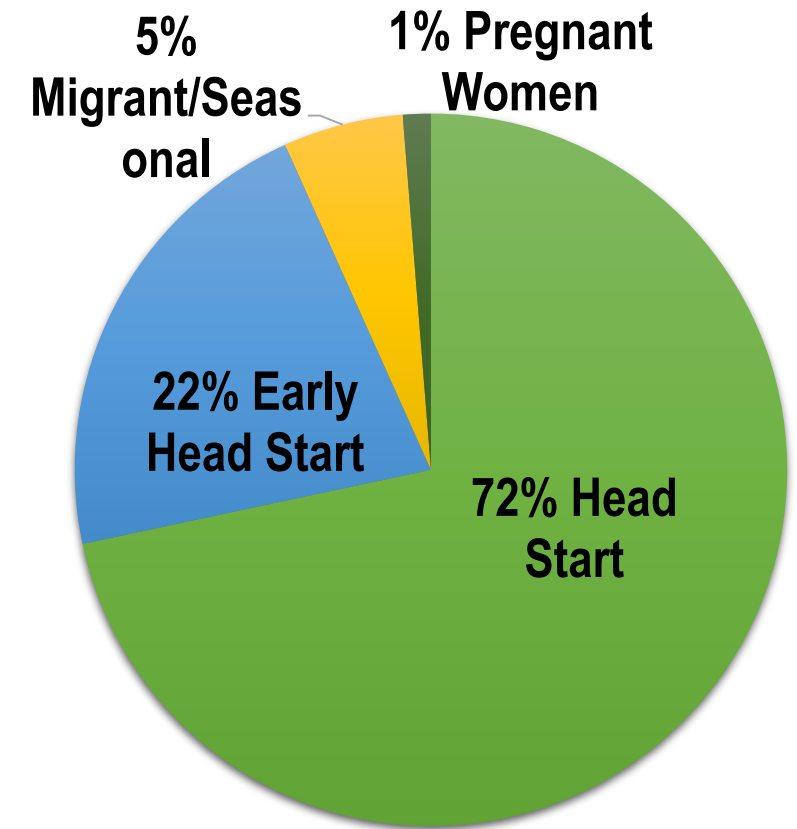

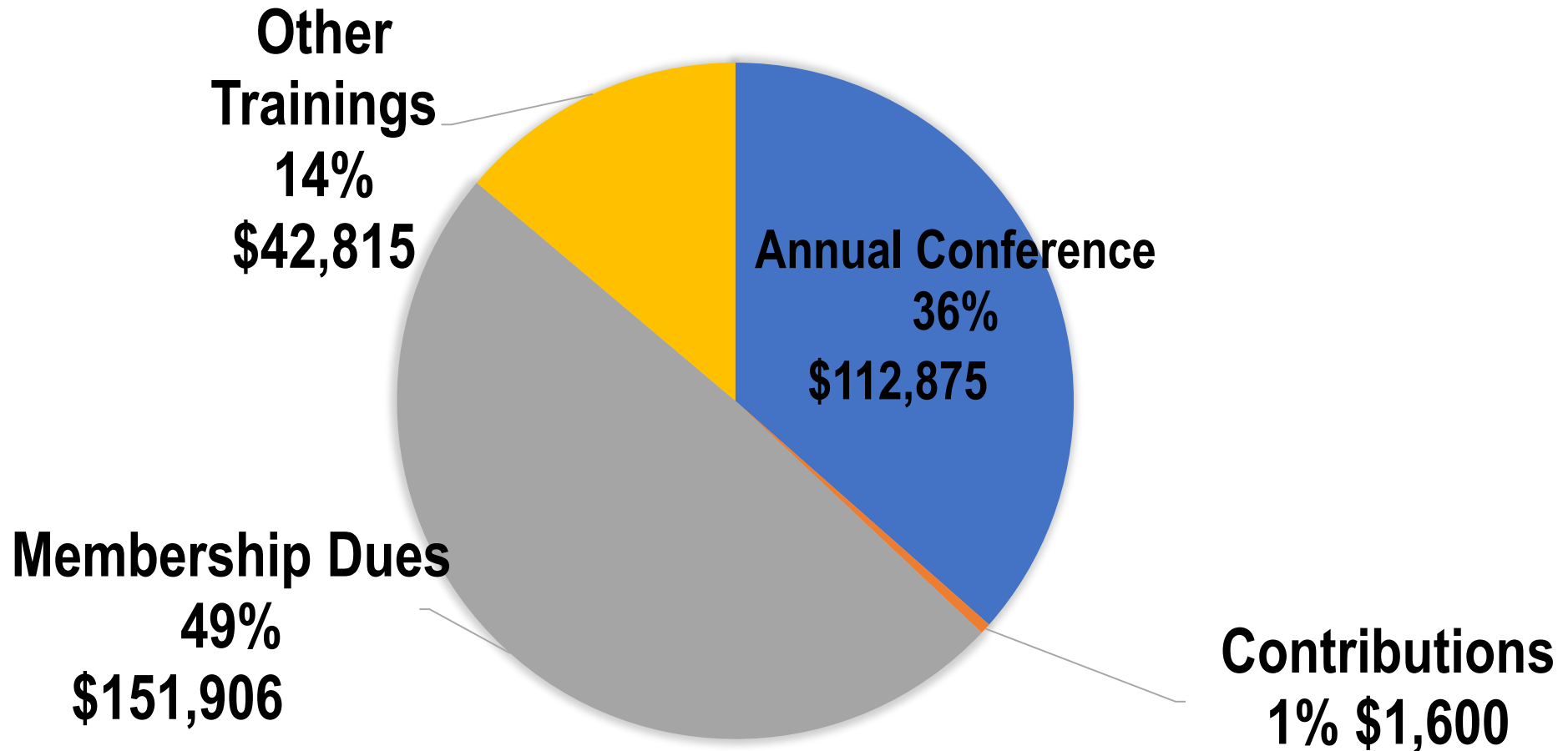

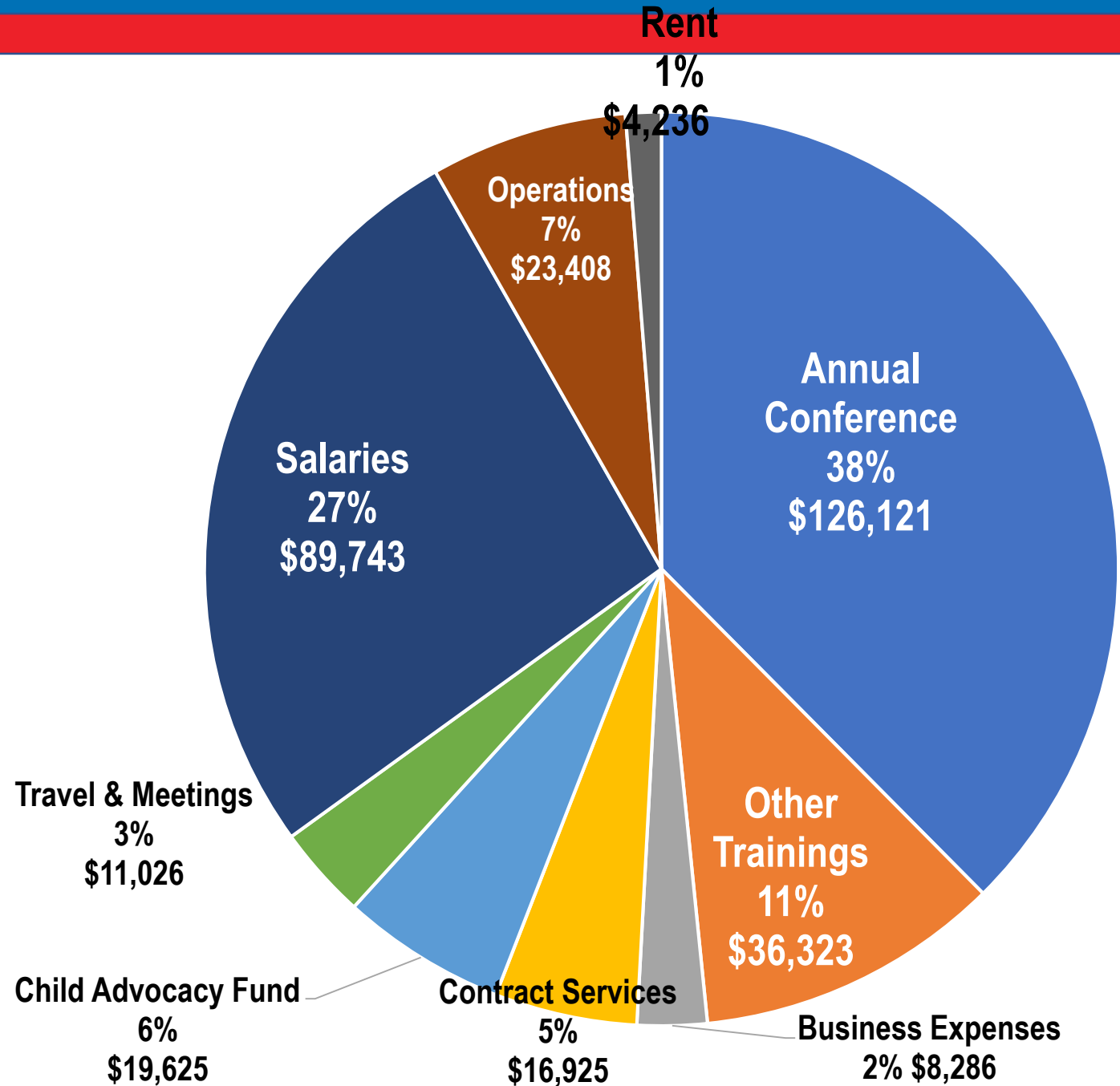

2018-2019 REVENUE

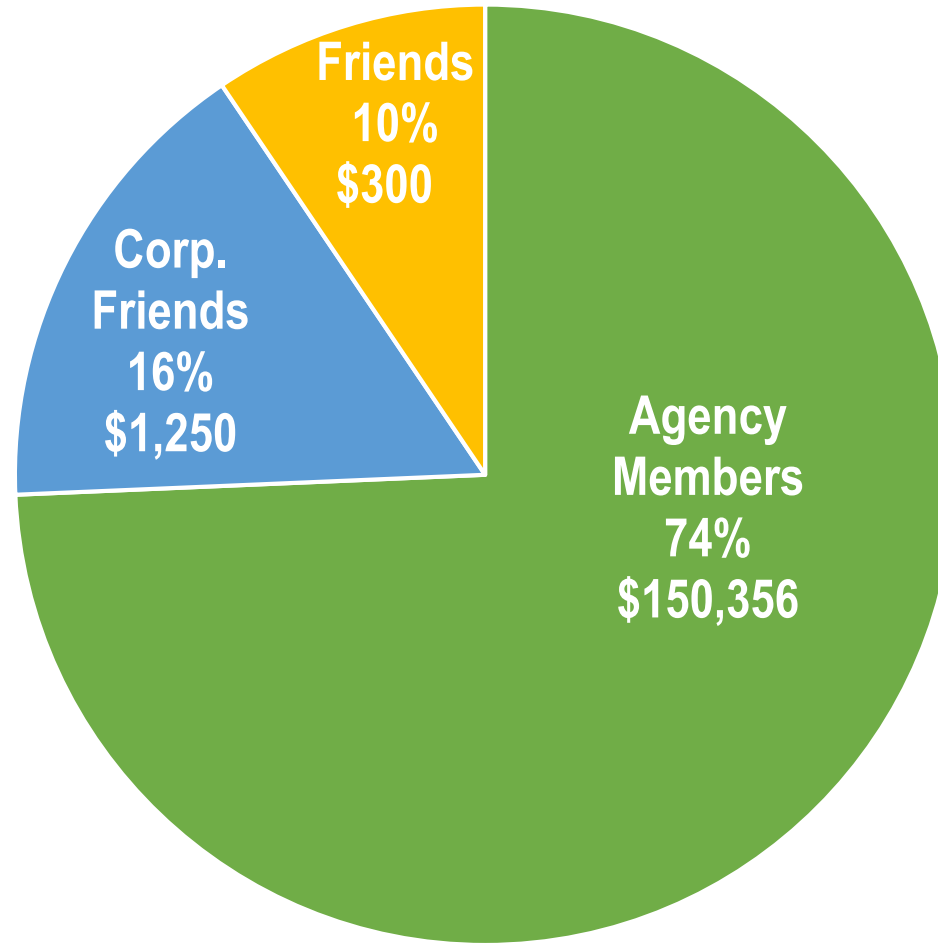


FHSA 2018-2019 EXPENSES

ADVOCACY

FHSA works with early childhood education and care providers and advocates to improve policy between state and federal regulations, and to ensure appropriate level funding to implement quality early childhood services.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

FHSA convenes an annual conference and fall leadership training each year tailored to the needs of Head Start leadership, staff, parents, and other partners. FHSA also is the state's Social Service Competency-Based Training (SSCBT) Credential (family service credential) coordinator, providing members access to SSCBT certification. In addition to these professional development opportunities, FHSA responds to the agency's needs for training and technical assistance to ensure quality services.

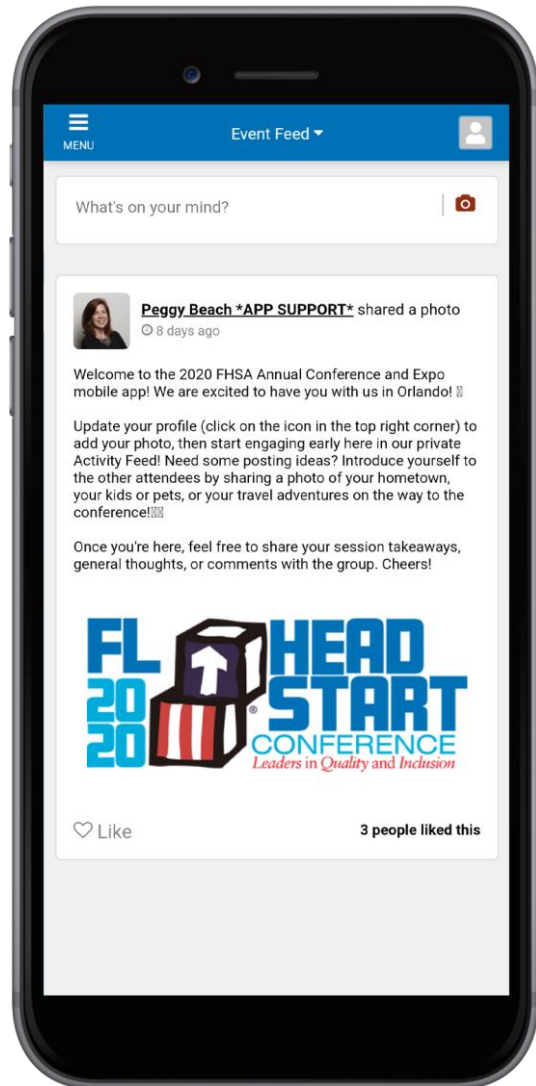

DOWNLOAD FHSA MOBILE APP



Step One:

From your mobile device, search for "EventMobi" in your app store. (NOTE: The FHSA 2020 event will be inside of the EventMobi app).

Step Two:

Once you download & open the EventMobi app, **enter the code: fhsa2020** and press the + sign to load this event. You will only need to do this the first time.

Step Three:

Login with your email address used to register for the conference. You will then be asked to **create your own unique password**. If you have used EventMobi before, you will be asked to enter your previous password. Click "Forgot Password" to reset if needed.

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
