

Children's Handwashing Rules

(Effective 8-25-10)

Children's hands shall be washed with <u>liquid</u> soap and <u>warm</u> running water as follows:

- · Immediately upon arrival for care
- · When moving from one child care group to another
- · Upon re-entering the child care area after outside play





Before and after:

- eating meals and snacks
- handling or touching food
- playing in water



After:

- · toileting and diapering
- playing in sand
- touching animals or pets
- · contact with bodily fluids such as, but not limited to, mucus, saliva, vomit or blood
- contamination by any other means

Staff Handwashing Rules

(Effective 8-25-10)

Personnel shall wash their hands with <u>liquid</u> soap and <u>warm</u> running water as follows:

- Immediately upon arrival for the day
- · When moving from one child care group to another
- · Upon re-entering the child care area after outside play





Before and after:

- · diapering each child
- · dispensing medication
- · applying topical medications, ointments, creams or lotions
- · handling and preparing food
- eating, drinking
- · preparing bottles, feeding each child
- assisting children with eating and drinking




After:

- · toileting or assisting children with toileting
- · using tobacco products
- handling garbage and organic waste
- touching animals or pets
- · handling bodily fluids such as, but not limited to, mucus, saliva, vomit or blood
- · contamination by any other means
