

# Mitigating the Spread of COVID-19 in Head Start Programs

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services published a final rule in January 2023 that removes the requirement for universal masking for all individuals ages 2 and older. This Final Rule requires that Head Start programs have an evidence-based COVID-19 mitigation policy, developed in consultation with their Health Services Advisory Committee (HSAC). ## <u>Federal Register Notice on Mitigating the Spread of COVID-19 in Head Start Programs</u>

The Final Rule removes the universal masking requirement from the Head Start Program Performance Standards (HSPPS) and requires Head Start programs to develop an evidence-based COVID-19 mitigation policy.

### ACF-PI-HS-23-01 Supplementary Information on Establishing an Evidence-based COVID-19 Mitigation Policy

This Program Instruction (PI) provides supplementary information to support grant recipients in operationalizing this requirement. Grant recipients are not limited to the considerations outlined in the PI when developing their evidence-based COVID-19 mitigation policy.

### **Revised HSPPS on COVID-19 Mitigation Policy**

Effective Jan. 6, 2023, the HSPPS at 45 CFR §1302.47(b)(9) requires Head Start programs to have an evidence-based COVID-19 mitigation policy developed in consultation with their HSAC that can be scaled up or down based on the impacts or risks of COVID-19 in the community.
