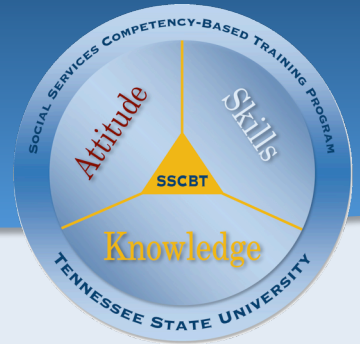

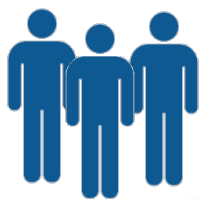

Training includes portfolio assignments designed to integrate the course learning with actual practice.

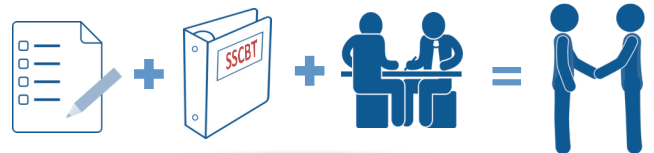
